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HOMEBOUND & HOSPITAL STUDENT SERVICES POLICY

A student absent from school for more than ten (10) consecutive days because of health or physical impairment may be provided educational services as appropriate in the home or hospital. Appropriate school officials will determine the types of education services to be provided. These services may include such strategies as remote learning options, assignment of a teacher or paraprofessional in the home, online content, study packets, etc. The educational services will be provided in coordination with the appropriate certified professional. Appropriate educational services may begin as soon as eligibility has been established by the District with a written statement from a licensed medical examiner and a written parental or guardian request. Anytime a homebound teacher or paraprofessional is provided, a responsible adult must be present with the student at all times.

Such students shall be included in calculating the average daily attendance.
