The Board all agreed; motion granted. The Board took a small break until the 9:00 a.m. hearing.

The Board reconvened into executive session at 8:56 a.m., for the second expulsion hearing. Others present: The attending Board members, Tim McMurtrey, James Gilbert, Albert Longhurst, student and parents, and Sharon Whitman. Following a full and complete discussion of student matters regarding the possible expulsion hearing, the Board reconvened into open session at 9:03 a.m. A motion by Trustee Murray to deny attendance to (Name on File) to Mountain Home School District for Zero Tolerance, violation of school district policy, drug related behavior, and actions deemed detrimental to the health and safety of students and staff received a second by Trustee Checketts. The Board all agreed; motion granted.

The Board entered back into executive session at 9:20 a.m., for the third expulsion hearing. Others present: The attending Board members, Tim McMurtrey, James Gilbert, Albert Longhurst, student and parent, and Sharon Whitman. Following a full and complete discussion of student matters regarding the possible expulsion hearing, the Board reconvened into open session at 9:29 a.m. A motion by Trustee House to deny attendance to (Name on File) to Mountain Home School District for Zero Tolerance, violation of school district policy, drug related behavior, and actions deemed detrimental to the health and safety of students and staff received a second by Trustee Reynolds. The Board all agreed; motion granted.

The Board again entered back into executive session at 9:44 a.m., for the fourth expulsion hearing. Others present: The attending Board members, Tim McMurtrey, James Gilbert, Albert Longhurst, student, parent, family member, and Sharon Whitman. Following a full and complete discussion of student matters regarding the possible expulsion hearing, the Board reconvened into open session at 10:05 a.m. A motion by Trustee Murray to deny attendance to (Name on File) to Mountain Home School District for Zero Tolerance, violation of school district policy, drug related behavior, and actions deemed detrimental to the health and safety of students and staff received a second by Trustee Reynolds. The Board all agreed; motion granted.

The Board reconvened back into executive session at 10:21 a.m., for the fifth expulsion hearing. Others present: The attending Board members, Tim McMurtrey, James Gilbert, Albert Longhurst, student, parent, family members, and Sharon Whitman. Following a full and complete discussion of student matters regarding the possible expulsion hearing, the Board reconvened into open session at 11:20 a.m. A motion by Trustee Murray to deny attendance to (Name on File) to Mountain Home School District for Zero Tolerance, violation of school district policy, drug related behavior, and actions deemed detrimental to the health and safety of students and staff received a second by Trustee Checketts. The Board was not in agreement with the motion therefore Chairman Alexander called for a roll call vote.

And no less than two-thirds (2/3) of the membership not in favor of expulsion thereof, the Chairman declared that the motion didn't pass and that (Name on File) was allowed to remain in school in the Mountain Home School District on the basis that he abides by a behavior contract as dictated by Mr. Longhurst and as long as he doesn't participate in any drug related behavior, and/or behave in a manner that is perceived as detrimental to the health and safety of other students and staff. Motion granted.

The Board took a small break before the next hearing.

The Board again reconvened into executive session at 11:37 a.m., for the sixth and final expulsion hearing. Others present: The attending Board members, Tim McMurtrey, James Gilbert, student (via telecommunications) and parents, and Sharon Whitman. Following a full and complete discussion of student matters regarding the possible expulsion hearing, the Board reconvened into open session at 12:10 p.m. A motion by Trustee Murray to deny attendance to (Name on File) to Mountain Home School District for Zero Tolerance, violation of school district policy, drug related behavior, and actions deemed detrimental to the health and safety of students and staff received a second by Trustee Checketts. The Board all agreed; motion granted.

II. ADJOURNMENT – All business of the Board having been completed, Chairman Alexander called for a motion to adjourn. A motion from Trustee Reynolds to adjourn was seconded by Trustee Murray. Motion approved. The meeting adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
