

SAFE & SECURE LEARNING/WORK ENVIRONMENT POLICY

The Board holds the safety of every student, employee and school visitor as one of its highest priorities. A safe and secure learning/work environment for students, staff and visitors is required in order to maximize educational opportunities. While the Board cannot guarantee elimination of all threats, the Board directs and supports the administration in the implementation of policies and procedures which are designed to reduce and minimize safety risks.

The Board requires that all conduct that is reasonably suspected to be a crime or serious incident which did or may compromise the safety and security of the District learning/work environment be reported to the Superintendent or designee. The Superintendent or designee will collect and analyze this data to identify problem areas and develop prevention/intervention strategies, policies and/or procedures to continually improve the safety of the school environment. In addition, all suspected crimes will be reported to the appropriate law enforcement agency.

Whenever appropriate, the District will cooperate with other individuals, businesses, organizations, or governmental entities to promote a safe community for the betterment of all children.
